

Vocal Music Booster Meeting

February 12, 2014

The meeting was called to order by President, Mike Kurriger at 6:36 p.m.

The Secretary Report was read and approved.

Treasurer's Report was given by Darcy Petersen. There is \$19,150.54 in unrestricted funds. A copy of the report is attached. The monies remaining in the "Charter Bus Fund" will be renamed as "Student Raised Fund" and entered as a line item in the books.

Old Business:

- River City Showcase – Wrap up meeting is being planned by Bonnie Nichols and she will email the date once scheduled. Many positive comments were received and preliminary reports are showing an increased profit from last year.
- Dessert concert - \$1185.31 profit. We had plenty of desserts donated so none had to be purchased. Some cheesecakes that were left over have been frozen for the show choir awards banquet. There was a conflict with rehearsal for the Interact talent show that caused mike and sound issues. Need to organize a committee to organize this during the September booster meeting since it comes so close to the River City Showcase.

Director's Report:

- Vocal concert March 3rd at 7:00 p.m.
- State Jazz – groups had to scratch due to all the weather delays.
- Community Fundraiser cards – none ended up getting sold during the invitational. Karen Stern will check with Ms. Burford about setting up sell dates at Wal-mart. It was decided to sell all remaining cards for \$5.00 each with \$2.50 per card to student's incentive account.

New Business:

- Interact Talent Show – RCR will perform at the end of the show on Thursday morning. This will be a good chance for the student body to see what show choir is all about.
- Romeo/Juliet show choir costumes – Becky is still trying to make contact with the costume shop. Mr. Ryan will inform the students they are available to purchase for \$20. Becky Schultz volunteered to be the contact for those students wanting to purchase their letter jacket/sweater.
- Senior Show Choir gifts – The past 4 years pillow have been made as gifts for the senior show choir students. This line item was deleted from the budget due to the deficit in unrestricted funds last year. There are 19 seniors and some parents feel student would be disappointed not to receive a gift this year. Discussion was to add this back into the budget at a price per student amount. The treasurer states there are funds to cover this expense. Susan Krueger made a motion to allocate \$10.00 per student for senior gifts, second by Darcy Petersen. Motion carried.
